On 01/19/2015 the Indian Point Police Department was contacted in regards to two stolen watercraft and the trailer they were on. An officer responded and collected evidence from the scene. Further evidence was collected from multiple surveillance cameras and local residents. After going through every video and picture available, a suspect vehicle was identified. The suspect vehicle description and descriptors of the stolen items were given to all law enforcement agencies in the surrounding area.

On 01/22/2015, a Stone County Deputy stopped a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle description. The suspect was arrested on unrelated charges. An Indian Point Officer was called to the scene of the stop to process evidence in regards to the stolen items. Indian Point Police Department filed charges with the Stone County Prosecutor.

On 01/23/2015, a detective with the Stone County Sheriff's Department and an officer with the Indian Point Police Department interviewed the suspect at the Stone County Sheriff's Department. Further interviews with known associates of the suspect were conducted by the Indian Point Police Department on 01/24/2015.

On 01/26/2015, an anonymous citizen located what appeared to be the stolen items on Hwy 248 just east of Hwy 13. This information prompted a response from the Indian Point Police Department and the Stone County Sheriff's Department. The items were positively identified as the stolen items in question.

It was later determined the suspect vehicle was also connected to stealing a utility trailer from the same area. In efforts to further connect the suspect to the crimes, the Indian Point Police Department and the Stone County Sheriff's Department worked together to obtain search warrants. Evidence was obtained which led to all items being recovered and a conviction.
