BOARD NEWS

As everyone has surely seen, the new electronic sign donated by the "Bill Turner Family" is now functional. We are so pleased to have this available to us, again thanks to the Family! After the codification, housekeeping was done on updating speed limit signs, etc. An Ordinance was passed in May to exchange the meeting nights between the Trustees Work Session & P&Z meetings; now the P&Z is on the 1st Tuesday of the month with the work session on the following Thursday. The mowing contract this year was again awarded to Premier Lawn Service, we appreciate the good job they do for the Village. The Village Clerk's vacation was approved for July 25th thru the 29th, so the Village office will be closed for that time period, The Village Attorney is drafting an amendment to the 2015 Sewer Ordinance to address crediting Crowne View for their Pool/Irrigation usage. The Board approved \$10,000.00 for the Village Clerk to accomplish the 3 road areas recently bid, the results of the those bids are included in the roads report. The Mid-Year Budget was submitted to the Board for approval at the August meeting.

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ROADS REPORT

The Jakes Creek Trail Project has been completed, and turned out Wonderful! It was completed just in time for the Memorial Day Weekend so that our visitors were able to enjoy the new pavement! Other improvements planned are the culvert in Caps Cove will be replaced the first week of August. The culvert to be installed diagonally on Wolfe Lane is supposed to be completed the week of July 25th. Then lastly, the culvert on the north side of Mayden Lane will be trenched open just after the beginning of August. The results have not been as timely as we'd like, but we do continue to try to keep improving and maintaining all our roads for the necessity of our residents and for the enjoyment of our Visitors!

P&Z COMMISSION

The Planning & Zoning has been busy. They have approved a yearly extension on the Bayside plat for Stillwaters. The Timbers had combined a couple lots to make a bigger lot to appeal to buyers, there were 2 lots combined on Meadow Hills lane for the construction of a garage. Clear Lake Investments was approved to construct their other condo building. Their will be 2 Public Hearings on August 2nd to address the re-plat of Rockwood Resort from Condos to Lodge units, then the other hearing will address the request for an amendment to the Ordinance for the Crowne View resort addressing road improvements and commencement of Phase II
